



Information about Housing Programs at The Durham Center

The **Independent Living Initiative (ILI)** is a short-term rental/utility assistance program for adult consumers of The Durham Center. ILI applications should be submitted for request for financial assistance only. However, ILI is not an immediate financial assistance program. Applications are reviewed by a team and if an individual's application is approved, it may take one or more weeks to receive assistance.

Please follow the link on the main Housing webpage to the ILI Information and Instructions document for more information and to determine if this application is appropriate for the consumer you are supporting.

The **Supportive Housing Programs** are HUD grant programs which provide permanent housing assistance, in connection with supportive services, to homeless people with disabilities and their families. Please be aware that the Supportive Housing Program is not an immediate housing program and that making an application is only the first step in assisting your consumer to obtain housing.

You may need to assist them with the following:

- Required documentation (identification, income verification, disability verification, etc.) to complete application
- Paying the application processing fee
- Signing the lease, establishing a move-in date
- Paying the deposit for the apartment
- Moving into the unit.
