Reauth 4 days (64 units) up to 30 days total. Unable to remain in the community due to severity of symptoms or as a diversion from the hospital. Must be medically stable. Reauths based on clinical information, but the service cannot be provided for more than 30 days in a 12 month period . Re-authorization based on medical necessity. For those persons not medically stable or in severe withdrawal.</p>
