Latest News on Incontinence Supplies from DME Suppliers

Since November 1, 2009, DME suppliers have been permitted to provide and bill for diapers and liners. Effective April 15 The Durham Center will no longer allow providers to use its CAP provider number for billing. Please work with DME suppliers to have these items provided for your consumers. Provider Quarterly Incidents Reports (Form QM11) are due April 10 if The Durham Center is your host LME, even if you did not submit any incident reports throughout the quarter. If you submitted Level II or Level III incident reports during the quarter, the number of individual incident reports must match the number of reports on your Provider Quarterly Summary.
