Clarification of NC-SNAP Requirements

NC-SNAP must be completed on all persons receiving I/DD services in North Carolina, including persons receiving State and Medicaid-funded services. Qualified staff at all group homes serving individuals with I/DD, including DDA and ICF/MR group homes, should be completing NC-SNAP annually for individuals with I/DD when independent case management is not responsible for the assessment. NC-SNAP should be completed in conjunction with an individual's annual person centered plan and a copy forwarded to the responsible LME as defined by the individual's Medicaid county as it corresponds with the LME's catchment area.
